## What are the benefits of the Great Hearts Summer College Tour?

Entertainment: We always make sure to venture out and discover the cultural attractions and local entertainment that could make a city feel like home! In Boston we have an amazing selection from the rich history of the city itself, to the monuments, exhibits, museums, theatres, parks, and restaurants it boasts today. We will be staying directly adjacent to Fenway Park in the very heart of the city! We can definitely look forward to taking in the sights and a show!

Expertise: Students are touring these colleges with experienced and knowledgeable counselors from across the Great Hearts Network. Counselors are able to guide students to make the most of their visits by asking and answering additional questions, drawing attention to relevant points of interest about each college, and engaging students in thoughtful examination and self-reflection. Colleges are sometimes willing to extend additional opportunities for touring student groups such as extended information sessions, lunch in a dining hall, or an audience with our regional admissions representative.

Experience: For many students, the Summer College Tour is an opportunity to exercise some independence while still under the care and supervision of a trusted adulted. They are able to experience something akin to dorm life by staying in hotel rooms with students from across the network, but have the benefit of shared experience from which to initiate their new friendships. They can get a feel for the colleges and the city in a manner which more closely resembles the life they will lead when they do attend college!
